TUCKSHOP POLICY

Rationale:

The College through its tuckshop seeks to provide a service to the College community through a selection of nutritious food for students and staff at reasonable cost.

Gospel Values:

Service, Learning, Community.

Policy Statement:

St Joseph’s College will provide a Tuckshop as a service to the community by providing a variety of nutritious foods.

Consequences:

1. The Tuckshop will encourage the development of good eating habits by students/ staff
2. It will provide students with practical learning experiences about making healthy food choices.
3. The convenor will be responsible to the Principal.
4. The convenor will work with any Tuckshop Committee duly established by the Principal.
5. The Tuckshop will attempt to maintain annual membership of and alignment with the Australian Schools Canteen Association or its equivalent.
6. The Tuckshop is to be run as an efficient small business with any profits to be used at the Principal’s discretion.

Procedures:

1. The convenor’s hours of duty, both paid and voluntary, will be clearly stated in her/his contract. The contract is renewable on a “continuing” yearly basis.
2. The convenor, with the assistance of volunteers, shall be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Tuckshop.
