Dear Parents,

I would like to extend an invitation for your child to attend our annual Music Camp which will be held at the **Alexandra Park Conference Centre** on the Sunshine Coast. All students participating in Concert Band, Jazz Ensemble, Junior Band, String Ensemble, and Boys and Girls Vocal Ensemble including Junior Choir are invited to attend. Music Camp will commence on **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> March (departing 3pm) and will conclude on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> March (returning to the College by 2pm).**

This year music camp will be held over a weekend with students missing one formal school day. Attendance at this camp is extremely important. The opportunity for concentrated rehearsals is vital for the progress of all our music ensembles. Many new pieces will be introduced and we will use the time to develop the performance standard of each group. It is important that all members of the ensembles attend.

Music Camp also offers students the opportunity to socialize with their music peers, and this helps team building within the ensembles. In between rehearsals, students will have the opportunity to swim at the camp pool, swim and walk along the beach, and participate in ten-pin bowling at the local alley. All activities will be fully supervised by teachers.

**Please note:** All phones will be collected each evening and returned to students in the morning to assist student with receiving adequate sleep. Students wanting to listen to music as they sleep must bring their music on an I-Pod or other non-phone device with earphones.

**The cost of Music Camp for each student is \$230.** The full cost of camp (including accommodation, meals, coach fares and specialist music tutors) is \$390 but this is subsidized by the College in appreciation of the time your child commits to representing the College through performance events of the Music Program. Payment must be finalized prior to music camp and is payable to the front office by **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2017**. No enrolments to music camp will be accepted after this date.

Each student must return the permission/medical form to the College by the due date. This can be submitted as an E-Form online or handed into the front office with your payment. Payment can also be made using the Qkr APP which can be downloaded to your phone.
