SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAM

Gain valuable agricultural experience and a qualification during your school holidays

Program overview

UQ Skills' High School Program provides training to senior secondary students (Year 11 and 12) towards the achievement of a Certificate II in Rural Operations (AHC21216) during the school holidays at The University of Queensland Gatton campus.

Students who undertake and complete the program receive a nationally recognised qualification while still at school. The program allows students to receive training that is directly related to the agricultural sector and aims to provide them with the knowledge and skills required to either join the workforce or continue on to further education.

This qualification provides an entry level occupational outcome in the rural sector and will impart skills and knowledge to enable participants to:

- Operate tractors, quad bikes and side by side utility vehicles
- · Operate and maintain small engine machinery
- Perform basic livestock handling
- Operate drones
- Safely apply chemicals

Delivery

The course is delivered through a combination of online learning and face-to-face block training during the school holidays at The University of Queensland Gatton campus.

Face-to-face training will be delivered over $3 \times 4-5$ day blocks during the school holidays. All theory and online assessment must be completed before attending the relevant block training.

Resource requirements

It is recommended that you have access to a reliable internet connection to access UQ Skills' online learning system Blackboard, and a computer with up-to-date software, including Microsoft Office, Adobe Acrobat Reader and Adobe Flash Player.

You must also bring to class a long sleeved shirt, long pants, enclosed work boots, a sun safe hat, sunscreen and water bottle.

Fees

VETIS - \$0

There are no student contribution fees for the AHC21216 Certificate II in Rural Operations for students who are eligible to receive funding under the Queensland Government's VET in Schools (VETiS) program.

Fee-for-service - \$3800

The VET investment budget will only fund one employment stream qualification. With this in mind, if you have previously enrolled in a VETiS funded qualification prior to enrolling in this program, you will:

- be ineligible for this program to be offered as a VETiSfunded qualification
- still be able to enrol into the Certificate II program as a *fee-for-service* student.

How to enrol

UQ Skills offers training to Queensland high school students via the Queensland Government's VETiS program.

To participate in the VETiS program, a student must:

- be in Year 11 or 12
- be a resident of Queensland and attend, and remain enrolled, in a Queensland school for the duration of the program
- not hold and not be enrolled in a VETiS qualification funded by the VET investment budget
- have agreement from their school and parents, and identify the VETiS program in their Senior Education and Training (SET) plan.
