For primary producers seeking off-farm employment, residents of drought affected communities who have had their employment affected by drought and job seekers. This program has been designed to prepare participants with entry level skills and knowledge to assist in finding employment in the meat processing facilities.

- Follow safe work policies and procedures and sharpen knives
- Apply hygiene and sanitation practices
- Comply with quality assurance and HACCP requirements; Overview of HACCP and communication at work
- Apply animal welfare and handling requirements
