Master Plan Strategy:

What strategic future the school wants to pursue?

Next 10 years focus on providing?

The need to do something significant every 2-3 years in terms of building.

Want to provide a first-class environment and facilities!

Need to prioritise strategy for basketball courts across McKenzie Street – if not a long term intent to utilise property, selling off in the short term may be best option?

Stages of works:

Stage 1 – Locker structures & Basketball half courts, + refurbishment to Robertson building (Completed 2019).

Stage 2 – Demolish Murphy & Fogarty Buildings, Upgrade Central Courtyard and James/MacKenzie street corner, Construct Mary Rice extension, groundsman move into Caretaker's house, and sell existing basketball court land? There may be a need to address on site carparking – however we could argue that we are not intensifying the use of the land as the Mary Rice is to replace the Murphy and Fogarty buildings.

Stage 3 – New Admin, Canteen, Amenities, and GLA's above Admin – new walkway connection

Stage 4 – Edmund Rice – Remove conservatory, convert space to act as Student services – such as Counsellor, learning support, responsible thinking class, IT, maybe include House leaders.

• Include canteen demolition and convert to Sports Utility Building, demolish sports storage sheds on oval. Create central undercroft area, adjacent to new canteen

Stage 5 – Demolish existing houses and Hall - New Sports Stadium or Performing Arts Centre. Potentially revise existing Mackillop Hall depending on what is decided regarding PAC or Sport Stadium new build. Carparking to the front of school to Crown Street (Depending on Council planning requirements addressing parking may have to occur in an earlier stage)

Additional Items:

- Discussed demolition of Textiles (Demountable) & Sward and replacing with 2 or 3 storey building;
- Currently 2 x new locker structures provide for 3 houses. 1 house lockers left in Fogarty building – proposed to be moved to new Mary Rice extension once constructed – approx. 240 lockers.
- Require updated timetabling.
- Require updated room utilisation.
- Need to find a permanent location for the groundskeepers shed.
- Discussions relating to the future of the Edmund Rice building. Agreed long term intent should be to work with the existing building.
- Intent to improve performing arts facilities throughout.
- Need to review the current library m2 area against BGA guidelines
