Cars parked on footpaths, nature strips or near intersections can create serious SAFETY HAZARDS.

Reduced visibility - Vehicles parked on footpaths/nature strips make it difficult for other users to clearly see and anticipate other road users' intentions.

Pedestrians in danger when forced onto the road - It is dangerous for pedestrians. especially children, if forced to walk on the road. Some pedestrians need the assistance of mobility devices which also require a little extra room.

Emergency services such as fire & ambulance are impeded - Vehicles blocking or restricting access can delay critical services from being delivered to businesses or residents.

It can seriously interfere with access or damage underground infrastructure and services - Fire hydrants, telecommunications, electricity and gas services may be underground and heavy and constant vehicle movements could cause serious damage to these services. Footpaths/nature strips are not designed for traffic and continual use can further damage paths causing hazards.
