**Important Details:**

- Students are **to meet Miss Scott outside in the foyer** at the front doors at **5.30pm**. We will then move inside to our upstairs allocated seats.
- All performances are in the Empire Theatre Auditorium.
- Parents are encouraged to watch the performance and can purchase tickets for \$13 ticket to view performances. (Non-competing students \$7.50 or \$3 U12)
- It is expected that students will stay for the FULL Choral performance as a courtesy to performers from all schools.
- Students need to wear their **Formal College Uniform** for all Eisteddfod performances.

**Girls –**

- All girls must wear the standard girls tie – no senior ties
- STOCKINGS NOT socks – all girls must wear black 20 denier stockings (not tights) with their skirt and black school shoes (available for purchase from the music office)
- Girls may wear white or blue shirts as per their school year level
- Polished shoes
- Long hair should be tied back with a purple ribbon (available at the music office for \$2)

**Boys –**

- LONG PANTS – all boys must wear long trousers
- Boys may wear white or blue shirts as per their school year level (long sleeved)
- Belts and correct school socks are essential
- All shoes must be polished
