Dear Parents, Carers and Students

This latest update provides information relevant for St Joseph's College given the ongoing contact tracing and the additional exposure sites that have been added.



Fortunately, St Joseph's College continues to be a school in a non-impacted area and the following information remains relevant:

- Staff or students who have been in impacted areas since 1.00am Saturday (31/7/21) need to
 follow the lockdown rules when back in their home community, including the face mask
 requirements and restrictions around movement.
- Students who reside in the lock downed LGAs also need to comply with the lockdown rules. This means they cannot attend school unless they are a child of an essential worker.

Further clarification regarding siblings who share the same household of students and staff who have been in impacted areas since 1.00am yesterday has been sought and we have been advised that they are also required to follow the lockdown rules, unless they are children of essential workers.

Students who have not been in an impacted area but would like to wear a mask at school are welcome to do so.

If your child is feeling unwell, please do not send them to school. It is recommended that they get tested, and quarantine at home until you receive a negative result.
