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### COVID Update #5 – Term 1, 2022

**Dear Parents and Carers** 

We look forward to welcoming all students back on-campus for face-to-face classes on Monday 7 February, 8:30am.

We would like to remind all families about a few key priorities as we commence on-campus next week.

- Students are not to attend the College, if they display COVID-19 symptoms. Each morning it would be helpful for students to conduct a self-check in relation to their health. If students have any acute symptoms, they should not attend school for the health of the whole St Joseph's College community. The symptoms that would be included in the self-check would include:
  - Fever, sore throat, runny nose, cough, shortness of breath, headache, fatigue, vomiting or nausea, diarrhoea loss of smell or loss of taste.
- Get tested if they display COVID-19 symptoms. If they test positive (or are a close contact as defined by Queensland Health) they will be asked to remain away from school until they are well or until the expiry of the designated isolation period.
- Notify the school if they test positive to COVID-19 or if they are identified as a close contact within 2 days of attending St Joseph's College for more than a 4-hour period. Please complete this form.
- Practice active hand hygiene and maintain safe social distancing.
- Mask wearing is compulsory for all high school students in line with the current health directive and it is our intention to require our community to wear their masks at all times whilst at the College unless they are outside and can socially distance. Student who may have a medical exemption from wearing a mask are required to have their parents communicate with the College. We would encourage these students to consider the use of a face shield.
- If parents are on campus you need to wear a mask at all times.

#### Reporting COVID-19 cases to the community

As it is likely that the school will continue to be impacted by cases of COVID-19 in the future, we will be updating the community about further developments on a daily basis by including information about the presence of cases within the school community via our SJC website.
